Major Job Responsibilities:

- Assist site leadership teams with creating, implementing and monitoring school improvement efforts (e.g. comprehensive achievement plan, building literacy plan, PBIS plan, etc.)
- Ensure core components of the Oregon K-12 Literacy Framework, and Springfield multi-tiered systems of support and instruction are successfully implemented
- Assist with the implementation of the English Language Arts core programming
- Consult with teachers on matters relating to instructional strategies, delivery methodologies and analysis of results, particularly in the area of literacy
- Assist with school-wide data collection and analysis
- Facilitate regularly scheduled fidelity checks for multi-tiered systems of supports for literacy
- Facilitate protocols (PLCs) and guide teacher teams in analyzing student work/assessment data, conducting error analysis, assisting in the development of data-driven instructional plans for re-teaching concepts, skills and/or targeted interventions, within or outside of core instruction
- Actively participate on all building level literacy teams
- Provide support for grade level teams which may include modeling of research based instructional strategies for core instruction, interventions and best practices
- Conduct classroom/teacher demonstrations and/or modeling on instructional strategies to increase learning
- Active member on district-level literacy teams to communicate and coordinate information across building teams and to district teams
- Network with other instructional coaches to share ideas and strategies based on research and best practice that support teachers in their work
- Attend district training/support sessions and collaborate with other district coaches to receive professional development, guidance and direction regarding the role of instructional coach in the school setting
