Description

Jasper Mountain School is a K-8 private school operated by Jasper Mountain, a private non-profit agency which provides services to emotionally disturbed children in residential and day-treatment settings. Jasper Mountain School is registered through the Oregon Department of Education as a Private Alternative School and special education provider. The school works closely with Springfield Public Schools, sharing various staff and education initiatives. Jasper Mountain operates at two agency sites--Jasper Mountain Center and SAFE Center. This position will serve students at the SAFE Center site.

Successful candidates will possess the following qualifications that support Jasper Mountain's vision and educational services:

- Valid Oregon teaching license with Special Education endorsement
- Experience working positively with Special Education students
- Ability to provide individual, small group and classroom instruction
- Ability to plan and teach special individualized programs for special needs students
- Ability to develop Individualized Educational Plans (IEPs) for identified students and conduct/participate in IEP meetings effectively
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with staff, students, parents and community
- Ability to work closely with the multidisciplinary team to improve the student education process
- Demonstrated ability to establish a sound system of classroom management, and the ability to work collaboratively with classroom behavioral/treatment staff, creating a therapeutic learning environment
- Experience and understanding of Response to Intervention (RtI)
- Possess effective written, verbal and interpersonal communication skills
- Participate in scheduled staff meetings and planning sessions
- Assist with student testing
- Other duties as may be assigned

Note: Agency practices include use of Crisis Prevention Institute (CPI) Non-Violent Crisis Intervention approach for de-escalation and safety; training provided.

Hours and Days: Jasper Mountain Schools operate on a year-round calendar. Our breaks are generally longer than other public schools (i.e. Spring Break is two weeks). Positions are for 200 days beginning August 29, 2017 (191 instructional days, 9 teacher work/development days).

Compensation: Pay rate depends upon years of experience in the field. Benefit package applies including employer-paid health insurance, training funds and paid time off.
