*Title* **Licensed Clinical Social Worker - Part Time - Gateways High School**

*Description* Springfield Public Schools seeks outstanding candidates for the part time (0.5 FTE) position of Licensed Clinical Social Worker at Gateways High School (GHS). This position provides regular counseling to students and families in need of support, both emotional and social. This position works four (4) hours per day from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Monday through Friday for 193 days per year.

#### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Provides regular counseling to students and families in need of social and emotional support, including individual and small group counseling
- Coordinates and collaborates with primary care givers and other community organizations to improve health outcomes for students
- Creates programs for students and families to promote emotional and mental health
- Provides information and inservice programs for staff about diverse emotional and social health
- Responds to day-to-day issues and unanticipated student crises at GHS during the course of a school day
- Facilitates referrals to other services as needed
- Provides crisis intervention as needed
- Works to meet student needs effectively and resolves barriers through follow-up, advocacy, and collaboration with GHS staff and other community partners
- Maintains accurate and timely records of activities, case management notes, and services provided to each student
- Participates in and provides information to staff
- Maintains confidentiality of students
- Other duties as assigned to support students throughout GHS

#### **Skills, Knowledge and/or Abilities Required:**

- Exhibits strong leadership, interpersonal and communication skills
- Treats others with respect, regardless of gender, race, sexual orientation, background, or ability
- Works well in a collaborative and team-oriented work environment
- Believes all students can learn given the appropriate supports
- Committed to students and displaying tenacity in helping them succeed
