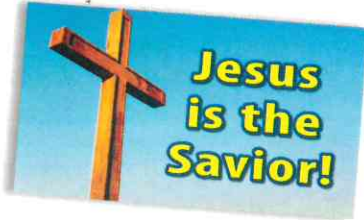

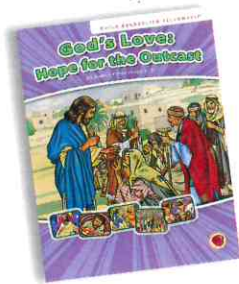

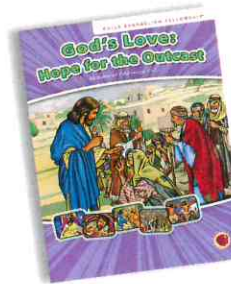
### Special COVID-19 disclaimer
