

Position: Insulin Injection Nurse

Personal Service Contract available for RN or LPN with current, unencumbered, Oregon nursing license.

Duties: Caring for diabetic students attending school in the Springfield Public School District.

Tasks include:

- Following physician orders to calculate and administer sliding scale insulin doses at lunch and/or breakfast time.
- Following physician orders in the proper treatment of diabetic students experiencing blood glucose levels that are not within normal limits.
- Communication with district nurses and school personnel regarding care provided for students and/or any abnormal findings.

Position requirements include:

- Current nursing licensure as described above.
- Current CPR
- Valid driver's license.
- Must have own, reliable transportation.
- English language fluency with good communication and documentation skills.
- Ability and willingness to work with school-aged children in busy school environments.

Hours available:

- Minimum of 2 hours per weekday during meal times.
- Up to 5 days per week while school is in session.
- Applicants with less than 2 hours of daily availability will also be considered.

Compensation:

- Minimum of 2 hours per weekday worked. If available less than 2 hours a day, pay shall be equal to actual time worked (rounded to the nearest quarter hour).
- RN: \$25.00 per hour
- LPN: \$18.00 per hour
